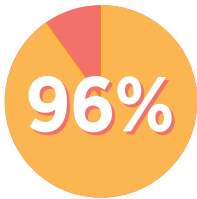

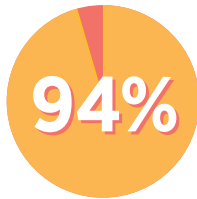

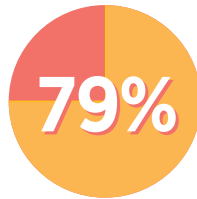
Parents and children spent **113,787** hours learning together, **26,922** of which was spent doing community service



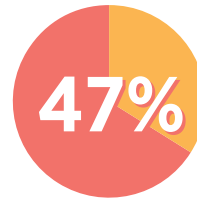
